Part 2	84	2.4.0	<u>Exhaust System</u> Original - Item No. 2.4.4. All chassis shall have catalytic converter/s theft prevention devices installed. These devices shall be designed to prevent additional heat build-up in the engine compartment and under the vehicle. The devices shall be removeable and reusable to allow for service/replacement of catalytic converters.

			<p>Change - Item No. 2.4.4. All chassis shall have catalytic converter/s theft prevention devices installed. These devices shall be designed to prevent additional heat build-up in the engine compartment and under the vehicle. Part 2	99	2.27.0	<p>Floor Covering</p> <p>Original - Item No. 2.27.2. There shall be a 2" wide white "Standee Limit" stripe set into the aisle covering located to the rear of the driver's section. The Standee Line shall meet the requirement of 49CFR section 393.90 and include a notice to passengers "<i>Law Prohibits Passengers Standing Forward of the White Line While Bus in Motion</i>", or approved equal phrase, posted in an area adjacent to white line and in clear view of passengers facing forward.</p> <p>Change - Item No. 2.27.2. There shall be a 2" wide white "Standee Limit" stripe set into the aisle covering located to the rear of the driver's section. The Standee Line shall meet the requirement of 49CFR section 393.90 and include a notice to passengers "<i>Law Prohibits Passengers Standing Forward of the White Line While Bus in Motion</i>", or approved equal phrase, posted in an area adjacent to white line and in clear view of passengers facing forward. Minibuses are not intended for standees and therefore associated signage must have signage stating "No Standing Allowed While Vehicle Is In Motion" or something equally similar.</p>
